

The Sixty-Minute Shakespeare makes reading (and understanding) Shakespeare so much easier. Having a shorter version without sacrificing the storyline or wonderful poetic language is a plus. The author includes footnotes with definitions of some of the more difficult words, saving you time by not having to constantly stop to look them up. This will be perfect for my middle school aged child

This abridged version of Macbeth retains all the main points of the story, yet shortens it to the point the entire play could be produced with an hour long run time. Along with the abridged script, the author included staging tips and nice footnotes throughout the explain the meaning behind Shakespeare's words. These books are short versions of the original plays and still include Shakespeare's poetic language. The author includes footnotes on many pages to explain the meaning of certain words that are not used in today's world.
