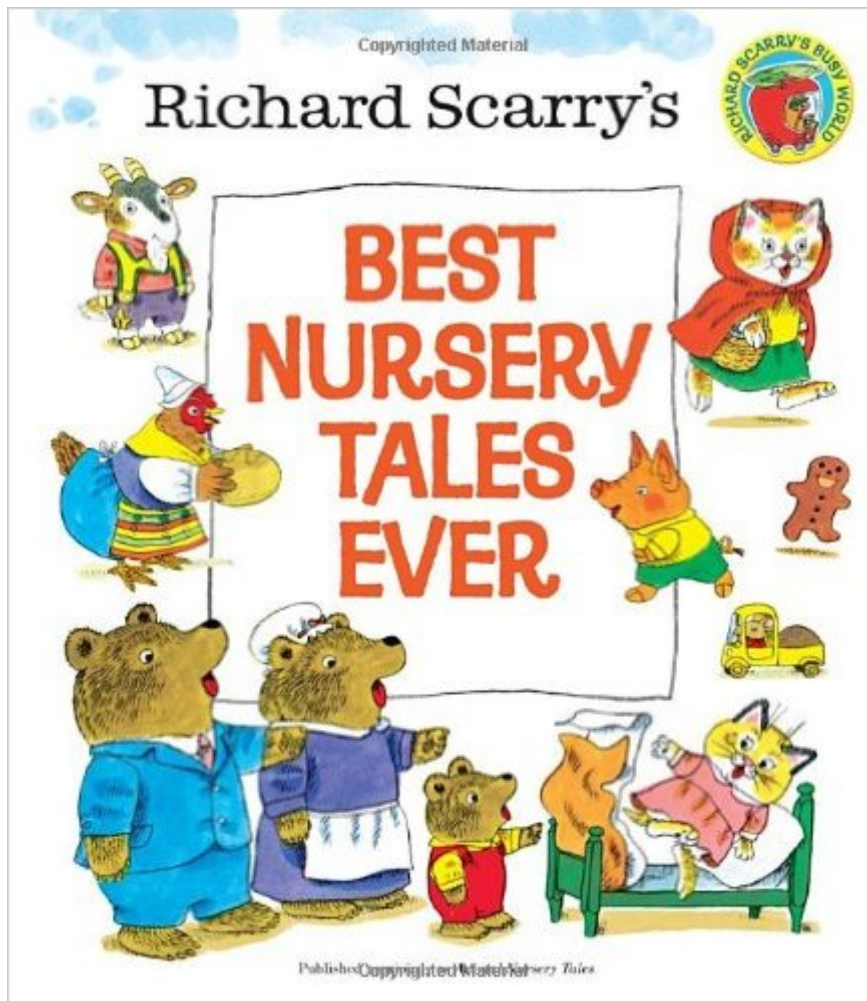

Nursery tales are known pretty well to those of us on Medicare. We know the story, it's the telling that makes the difference. These are told with the right combination of suspense, danger, compassion, humor and surprise. They are fun to read and memorable.

Another favorite Richard Scarry "big book" for us. We love the Busytown series, and all of our children, from the six year old down to the seven month old, love this one. We were familiar with most of the stories (ie, Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Bears, and the Billy Goats Gruff), but the Teeny Tiny Woman, which was a new one for us, has especially been a hit. I think it was meant to be kind of a "scary" story, and ended up making us all laugh in the end. Can't go wrong with Richard Scarry!
