Rodman's fresh, believable characterizations of Haley and her new teacher, Ms. Gray (!), are a true delight. Beautiful illustrations by Beth Spiegel add to a great reading experience.

I think it's a great book to start a conversation about how things, will be different in first grade. New teacher, new routines, new rules. It may seem to stink at first but it does get better.
