

There are nine chapters: Rosh hashana, Yom Kippur, Succos, Chanukah, Purim, Pesach, Counting the Omer and Lag BaOmer, Shavuos and Tisha B'Av. Every chapter consists of 2 parts: the story about the holiday and laws of the holiday.The stories are wonderful, they really sound like exciting stories for preschoolers, not like a history book. Besides the story there are interesting facts from Midrash in the additional boxes (Did you know? and Closer look) which might be interesting for parents and older children.The pictures in the book are really wonderful and there are a lot of them. I love these beautiful pastel colors! And all the people in the pictures are dressed modestly, if this is an issue for you.
